

PFSC Changes in Membership Application for 2016-2017

Dear PFSC Club Members:

Membership renewals are just around the corner. Two new requirements will take place for the July 1, 2016 – June 30, 2017 membership year.

Fees Increase

In May 2015, United States Figure Skating (“USFS”) voted to increase membership fees for all USFS member clubs nationwide that will now take into effect during the 2016-2017 membership year. As a result, PFSC is required to increase its membership dues and will only increase its fees by the amount that USFS has required. The new membership fees will increase by _____ and will be reflected in the 2016-2017 membership application.

Volunteer Hours Requirement

The Pasadena Figure Skating Club (“PFSC” or “Club”) is a non-profit organization that holds annual events, competitions, testing, board and committee meetings, skating shows, social activities, and awards (“Club Event”) all for the benefit of its members. In order to meet PFSC’s goals of creating a positive environment to promote and develop the sport of figure skating and to continue the success and activities of the Club, for the 2016-2017 membership year, all members are required to volunteer a minimum of five (5) hours per membership year (July 1st through June 30th) at Club Events. In lieu of volunteering five (5) hours per membership year, a club member may choose to make a donation of Fifty Dollars (\$50) to PFSC.
