A scholarship committee made up of teachers, former synchro coaches, and sponsors will review all applications, and choose a recipient for the Rose City Crystals' College Scholarship. Current RCC parents, coaches, and team manager will not be included in the scholarship committee.

Who Can Apply

For the 2024-25 Rose City Crystals' college scholarship, all Junior and Senior high school students who have skated on any USFS Rose City Crystals teams are eligible. You can have skated at any time with RCC to be eligible for this scholarship.

Rules

All applicants must be a Junior or Senior in high school, and be a current or former member of a USFS Rose City Crystals team. Applicants may apply more than once, if they have not have already been awarded the Rose City Crystals' college scholarship.
